



Centrestage 'On the Road' brings a flavour of what we do at Centrestage, Kilmarnock to communities and provides the energetic environment for people to come together to enjoy everything #funfoodfolk.

We first launched Centrestage 'On the Road' back in 2014 in Ardeer, North Ayrshire where we also established our now widely recognised dignified food provision. 'On the Road' now visits many towns and villages every week throughout Ayrshire.

Our Dignified Food Provision model has been developed since 2014 through our partnership with STV Children's Appeal, The Hunter Foundation and Scottish Government and provides a dignified alternative to foodbanks for folks across Ayrshire experiencing food insecurity

Over 8000 portions weekly, created from high quality surplus food by our team of chefs, are redistributed to individuals and families across more than 20 locations in Ayrshire each week. Beneficiaries can take what they need and pay what they can and no referral is required to benefit.

We are so grateful for the support of our food partners in helping us identify and maximise the amount of food that we can redistribute to those requiring support, whilst significantly minimising the amount of food going to landfill.
